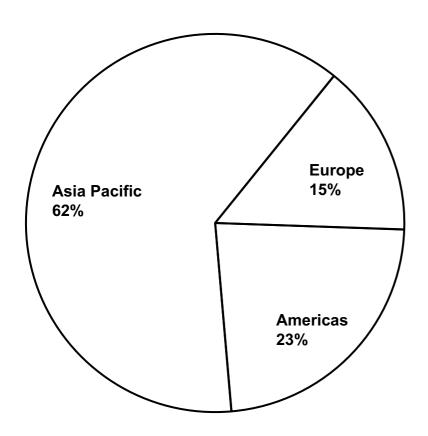

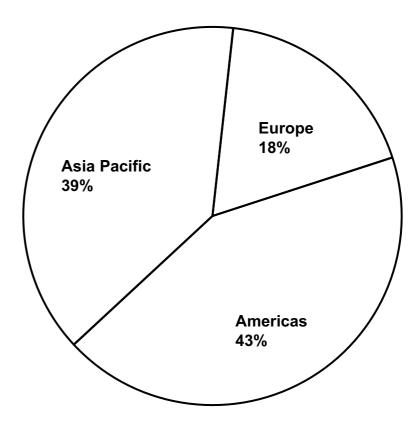

Revenue

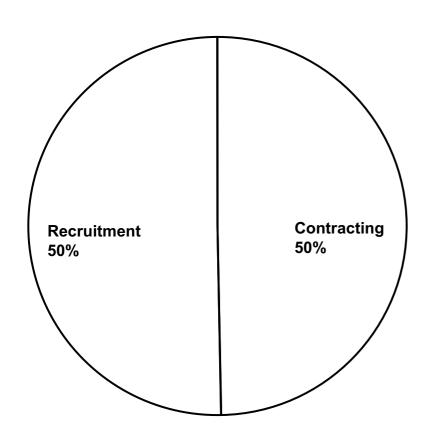


Adjusted Net Revenue

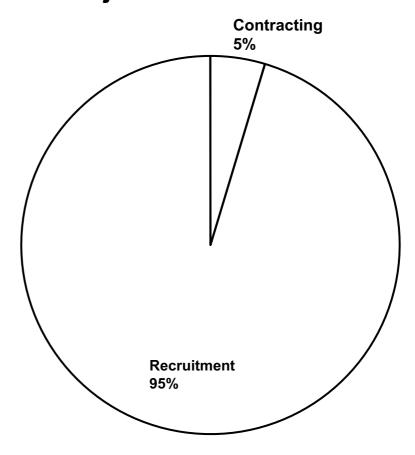


Q4 2022 RPO Services Split
