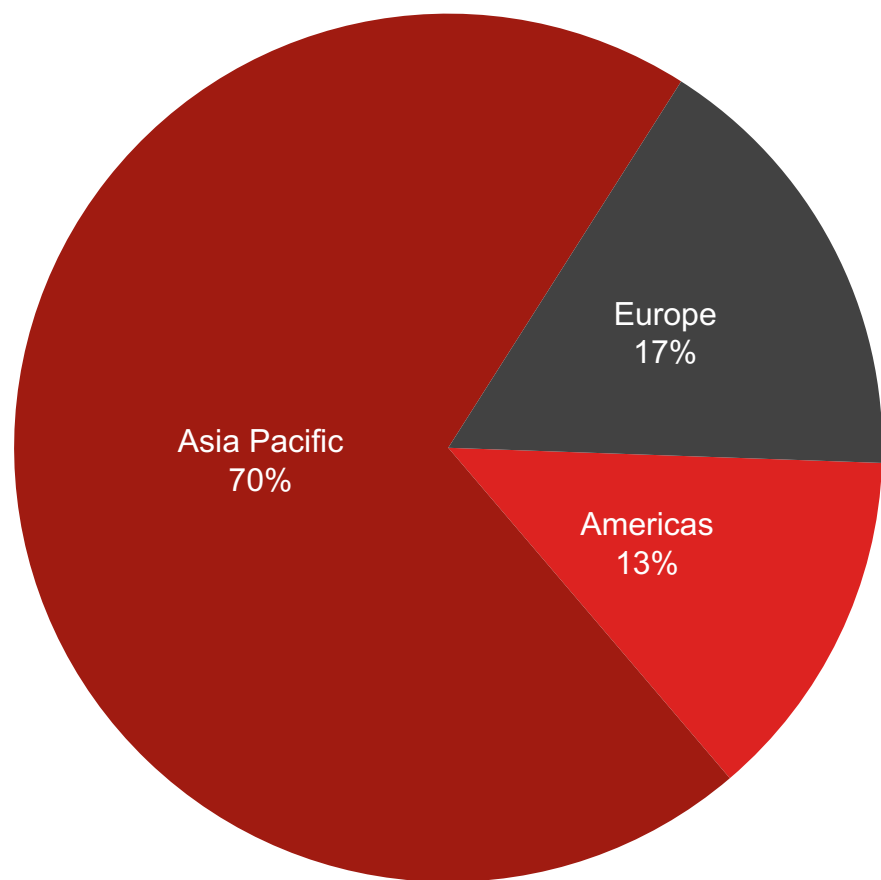

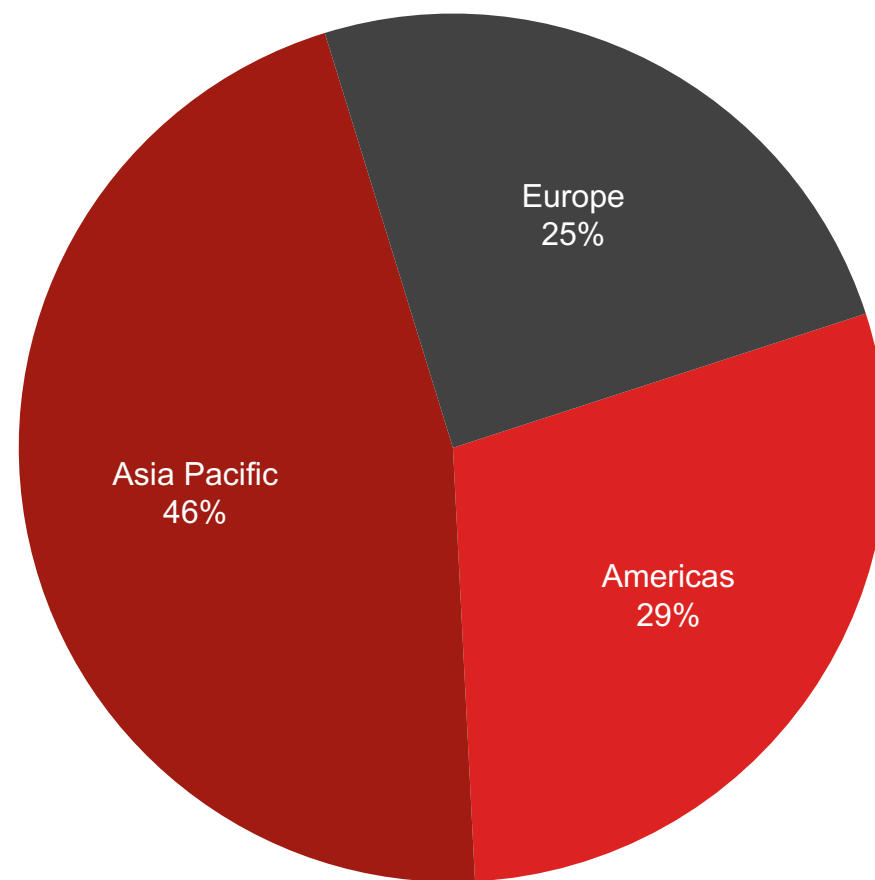

## Revenue

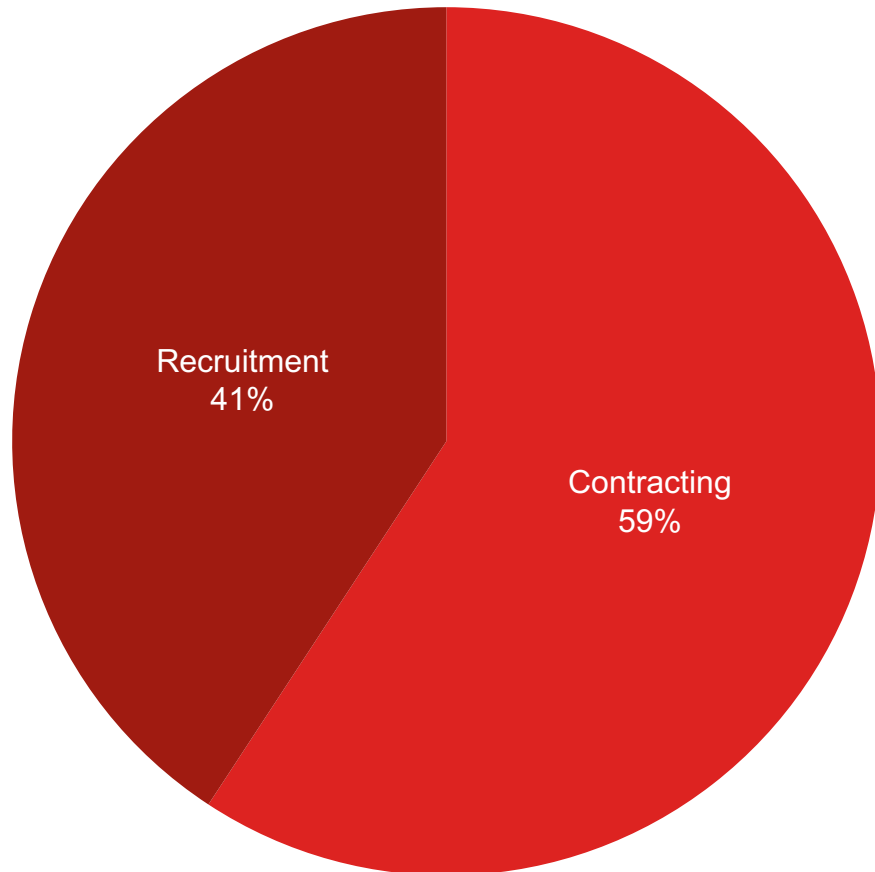


## Adjusted net revenue

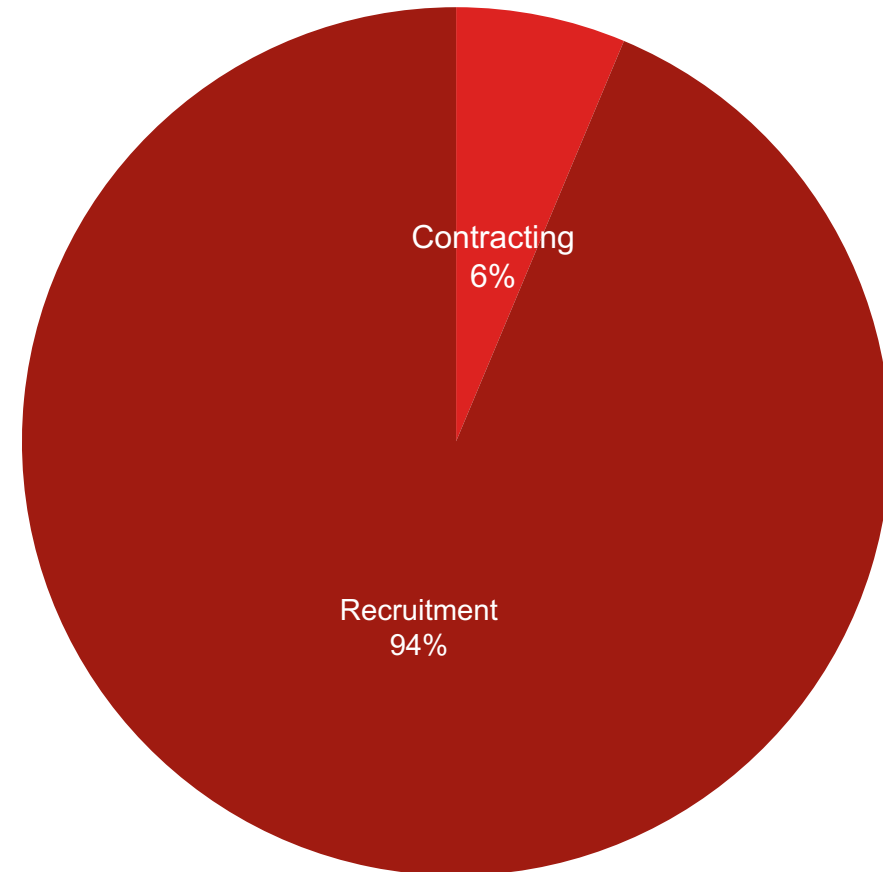


# Q1 2020 RPO Services Split
